

How to use the map

- In the LTFE Overview Map the experiments are shown on the exact position if the coordinates are known. This will be displayed in the last zooming layer. Sometimes more LTFE belong to a similar area; at a smaller scale the points will be dispersed to enable an overview of the number of the experiments of that area.
- A pop-up-window appears by clicking on one LTFE dot. This pop-up-window shows detailed information about the LTFE such as name, start of the trial, holding institution, research topic, positional accuracy etc. The pop-up-window shall be closed before changing the zoom level.
- The search field offers the following options:
 - o Searching by LTFE-name
 - o Searching by location
 - o Searching by institution.

Automatically search suggestions will be displayed.

- o By entering the name of an experiment all available locations and institutions containing an experiment with this name will be displayed.
- o By entering a location all experiments of this location or all experiments from the institution of this location will be displayed.
- o By entering the name of an institution all experiments from this institution will be displayed.

After selecting one of the search suggestions and clicking on "Search" the relevant map section is zoomed in, the experiment is marked and a pop-up window will open. Close the pop-up window and remove the marked area by clicking once at the map (outside the marked area) before starting a new search or changing the zoom level.

- At the left side different categories are displayed. Click at „+“ to disaggregate one category. It is possible to deselect one or several fields.
- Use „+“ , „-“ or the wheel of the mouse to zoom in the map. Leave the mouse on the area which you want to zoom in if you use the wheel of the mouse. Click on the house-symbol to get back to the standard scale level of the map.
- Another possibility to zoom in: press "Shift" and click on the left mouse button to mark a rectangle on the map where you want to zoom in.
- The button „Basemap Gallery“ contains a selection of background maps. Change the existing background map for example to an aerial view by clicking on the respective map.
- General information about BonaRes, LTFE and this overview map can be found under the blue "i".
- A paper symbol is located next to the „i“ with content information about the map.
